(U)2906.—Uniform—Ratings—Candidates for Promotion to Acting Sub-Lieutenant (S.D.)—Wearing of Distinguishing Flashes

(V.2A/79/15/60.-4 Nov. 1960.)

The white shoulder flashes at present worn by Upper Yardmen are in future to be worn on blue uniform suits by Naval S.D. list candidates attending prequalifying courses.

- 2. A gratuitous issue of 4 No. flashes, Vocab. No. 35471, is to be made to all Naval S.D. list candidates at present on, and in future to those commencing, prequalifying courses. Any subsequent replacements are to be taken up on repayment.
- 3. These ratings are also to wear a 1-in. white "sleeve", Vocab. No. 35470, on both shoulder straps of foul weather garments and 2 No. are to be issued on loan with each foul weather garment.
- 4. B.R. 93 (Victualling Manual) and the Uniform Regulations (Ratings) will be amended.
