## \*409.—Uniform—Badges—Submarine Ratings (V.2A/79/8/58.—14 Feb. 1958.)

Their Lordships have approved the wearing by ratings of a submarine badge ject to the following conditions. The wearing of this badge by qualified ratings I be optional and the badge will be made available for issue on repayment only.

- 2. Qualification.—The qualification for the badge will be the successful completion the oral examination conducted by Ships' boards between four and six months or ratings join their first submarine.
- 3. For ratings whose service in submarines began before the institution of this mination and who are still serving in submarines, permission to wear the badge t the discretion of the Submarine Commanding Officer, either with or without an mination according to the circumstances. There is, however, to be no examination Chief Petty Officers and Petty Officers.
- 4. Submarine ratings who have returned to general service may apply, through r Commanding Officer, to the Flag Officer, Submarines, who will authorise the ring of the badge provided the rating concerned is eligible.
- 5. Wearing.—The badge is to be worn on blue and white uniform suits only. It is to be worn on overcoats, action working dress, overalls, tropical shirts or singlets. badge is to be worn by C.P.Os. on the cuff of the left sleeve  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch above the centre on, and by other ratings  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inches from the lower end of the left sleeve of the jacket c or jumper without cuffs. On jumpers with cuffs, it is to be worn  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inches above top of the left cuff.
- 6. Forfeiture.—Normally the holder of a submarine badge may continue to wear badge after he has reverted to general service. Permission to wear the submarine may, however, be withdrawn if the holder has:—
  - (a) been removed from submarine service for disciplinary or other reasons within his own control, or
  - (b) failed to complete his first five-year period of service in submarines (Q.R. and A.I., Article 0814, paragraph 5).
- 7. The withdrawal of permission to wear the badge will be subject to Flag Officer, parines' approval in each case.
- 8. Records and Reports.—The grant or withdrawal of permission to wear the sarine badge is to be recorded at the foot of page 3 of the rating's Service ficate. In addition, the names and official numbers of ratings granted permission are the badge in accordance with paragraphs 2 and 3 above are to be reported to lag Officer, Submarines.
- 2. Stocks of these badges are now available on demand from the Victualling s at Home and will be available shortly at H.M. Victualling Yards, Malta and pore. Requirements for the 4th and 6th Submarine Squadrons should be ned from H.M.S. "Dolphin". The issuing prices of the Submarine badges are lows:—
