*1077.—Relative Rank of Commissioned Officers of the Royal Navy, Royal Marines, Army and Air Force.

(C.W. 1375.—17.4.1925.)

Commissioned Officers of the Royal Navy, Army and Royal Air Force will in future rank with one another, according to seniority or date of appointment, as follows :—
