

*1595.—Badges—Gunnery Ratings

(V. 1211/35.—4.7.1935.)

With reference to the changes promulgated in A.F.O. 826/35, the non-substantive badges to be worn by director layers, gunlayers and rangetakers under the new arrangements are as follows :—

<i>Rating.</i>	<i>Badge.</i>	<i>Pattern Nos.</i>
Director layer	... Crossed guns with star above and star below.	{ 108-108c (C.P.O.s). 109-109B (other ratings).
Gunlayer	... Crossed guns with star above	{ 110-110c (C.P.O.s). 111-111B (other ratings).
Rangetaker, 1st class...	Rangefinder with star above and star below.	{ 230-230B (C.P.O.s). 231-231B (other ratings).
Rangetaker, 2nd class	Rangefinder with star above	{ 232-232B (C.P.O.s). 233-233B (other ratings).

2. Men who continue to hold the rating of director layer, 1st class, old system, or gunlayer, 1st class, old system, may continue to wear the badges hitherto authorised for these ratings.

3. The Uniform Regulations will be amended as necessary.
