

2471.—Uniform—Officers—Shoulder Straps in Khaki Uniform

(N.L. 7199/41.—12.6.1941.)

Their Lordships have approved, as a temporary war-time measure, in cases where Khaki uniform is ordered to be worn (*vide* Section 41 of the Uniform Regulations for Officers of the Fleet) that either—

- (a) a Blue shoulder strap with gold distinction lace, or
 - (b) a Khaki shoulder strap with Khaki braid distinction lace
- may be worn by Naval officers.
