

2590.—R.N.A.S. Uniforms—Pattern of Stars.

(N.L. II. 22374.—13.7.1917.)

The star worn on the sleeve by graded officers of certain ranks in the Royal Naval Air Service is to be of the same size and design as the epaulette star worn by officers below the rank of Rear-Admiral, but in gold instead of in silver.

2. On the shoulder-strap the star will be of a similar pattern, but of one-half the diameter.

3. The two stars worn by Squadron Commanders of less than eight years' seniority as Flight Lieutenant, Flight Commander and Squadron Commander will be worn in a vertical line on the sleeve and in a horizontal line on the shoulder strap.
