

**3006.—Uniform—Badges—Royal Marines—Badges, Cap, Lion and Crown, with Pin—
Introduction**

(V. 2C/62/3/57.—29 Nov. 1957.)

A new pattern of Lion and Crown cap badge, Vocab. No. 35900, fitted with a stick pin fastener is being introduced for wear by R.M. Officers, Regimental Sergeants Major and Quartermaster Sergeants in replacement of the present type badge, Vocab. No. 35901, fitted with horizontal lugs and split pin fastener. No further purchases of the latter type will be made.

2. Until stocks of Vocab. No. 35901 are exhausted all new entrant officers and, on promotion, Regimental Sergeants Major (except ex-Quartermaster Sergeant) and Quartermaster Sergeants are to receive one badge of each type as follows :—

Vocab. No. 35900	For wear on plastic cap.
Vocab. No. 35901	For wear on beret.

3. The new badge will be available on repayment at a Fleet Issuing Price of 10*d.* each.

4. Stocks of the new badges are available at Admiralty Storage Depot (Victualling), Risley, Warrington, Lancs, and H.M. Victualling Yards, Malta and Singapore.
