

## 3567.—Royal Marines—Specialist Allowances.

(C.W. 26067 /19.—1.11.1919.)

The specialist allowances mentioned in M.O. 2483a /19, App. II (A) V, will be payable only to R.M. Officers holding definite appointments for specialist duties ashore or afloat. No two allowances are to be paid concurrently to one Officer.

The following allowances formerly issuable at the R.M. Divisions are now abolished, as from 1st July 1919, and specialist allowances, where applicable, will be granted in lieu to Officers appointed for specialist duties:—
