

3808.—Uniform—Badges—Electrical Mechanics

(V.1D/2008/53.—11 Dec. 1953.)

Badges as shown below have been introduced for wear by Electrical Branch Mechanics not entitled to trade pay. The design consists of diagonal lightning flashes superimposed on an end-on view of a generator with terminal blocks and shortened tail leads. Distinguishing letters, as shown, will be worn in the centre of the badge to distinguish the four categories. A crown will be worn above the device by Electrical Branch Mechanics 2nd and 3rd class, and a crown above and a star below the device by Electrical Branch Mechanics, 1st class.
