

4227.—Establishments—Royal Naval School of Music—Transfer

(R.M. 7/8/35.—16 Dec. 1949.)

The move of the Royal Naval School of Music from Burford to Deal referred to in A.F.O. 3264/49 will take place as follows :—

- (a) Boy Musicians, Boy Buglers and necessary staff on 6th January, 1950.
- (b) The remainder of the Royal Naval School of Music on 1st February, 1950.

2. The Depot, Royal Marines, Deal, and the Royal Naval School of Music will merge on 1st February, 1950, under one Commanding Officer, known as "The Commanding Officer, Royal Marines, Deal and Commandant, Royal Naval School of Music".

3. All correspondence affecting the personnel of Royal Marine Bands and on musical matters will continue to be addressed to the Commandant, Royal Naval School of Music, Royal Marines, Deal. All other correspondence for the Royal Marines, Deal, will be addressed to the Commanding Officer, Royal Marines, Deal.

4. Telegraphic addresses will be as follows :—

- (a) "Music, Deal" on all matters affecting the Royal Naval School of Music as in paragraph 3 above.
- (b) "Marine, Deal" on all other matters.
