

**529.—Uniform—Badges—Royal Marines—Colour Sergeants Arm Badge—
Re-Introduction**

(V.2C/62/13/54.—1 Mar. 1957.)

It has been decided to re-introduce, for wear on the present No. 1 Dress, the Ceremonial Arm Badge formerly worn on best blue uniform suits by Colour Sergeants, Royal Marines. The badge which is slightly smaller than the former pattern is designated Badge Arm, Colour Sergeant, Vocab. No. 31927. It is to be worn on the right arm above the chevrons in place of the crown at present in use.

2. Arrangements for the introduction of the new badge are :—

- (a) Serving Colour Sergeants to receive an initial free issue of one badge.
- (b) Sergeants promoted in future to receive an initial free issue of one badge in lieu of one Crown, Colour Sergeant, Vocab. No. 31922.
