

**(U)599.—Uniform—Ratings—Badges—Wearing on No. 10 Dress by Masters-at-Arms**  
(V. 3A/79/12/60.—17 Mar. 1961.)

In order that Masters-at-Arms shall be readily distinguishable they are, in future, to wear with No. 10 Dress, a gold badge attached to a white band on the right wrist.

2. A gratuitous issue of 1 No. badge, Vocab. No. 34172, for this purpose is to be made to all Masters-at-Arms at present serving and to those promoted in future. All such issues are to be noted in Pay Books (Forms S.43a). The white bands required for wearing these badges are to be provided by the Masters-at-Arms.

3. B.R. 93 (Victualling Manual) and the Uniform Regulations will be amended.
