

635.—Badge for Officers of the Air Branch

(N.L. 81/38.— 24.3.1938.)

His Majesty the King, has approved the adoption of a distinctive badge to be worn by officers of the Air Branch, consisting of a capital letter A in silver, enclosed within a laurel wreath of gold embroidery.

2. This badge is to be worn in the centre of the left sleeve immediately above the curl in the uppermost row of distinction lace, one quarter of inch above the curl (or in the corresponding position in the case of officers who do not wear the curl). It is also to be worn on both shoulder straps with the Great Coat, White Tunic and White Mess Jacket and in Tropical Dress.

The badge is illustrated below.
