

995.—Royal Marines—Introduction of Arm Badge “Royal Marines” for Wear with Service and Battle Dress

(V.—6.3.1941.)

A woven arm badge showing the designation “Royal Marines” has been introduced for wear with service dress and battle dress, and supplies will shortly be available at R.M. establishments.

2. The scale of issue is two for each suit of service dress or battle dress in the authorised kit. Metal shoulder titles will not be worn with these arm badges.
3. The badge has the designation “Royal Marines” woven in straight scarlet lettering on blue ribbon $\frac{1}{2}$ -in. wide and 4-in. long. It will be worn at the top of each sleeve of the service dress jacket or battle dress blouse above all other badges or signs.
4. The arm badge will not be worn by Colonels, R.M., and above (acting, temporary or permanent).
