## 995.—Royal Marines—Introduction of Arm Badge "Royal Marines" for Wear with Service and Battle Dress

(V.-6,3,1941.)

A woven arm badge showing the designation "Royal Marines" has been introduced for wear with service dress and battle dress, and supplies will shortly be available at R.M. establishments.

- 2. The scale of issue is two for each suit of service dress or battle dress in the authorised kit. Metal shoulder titles will not be worn with these arm badges.
- 3. The badge has the designation "Royal Marines" woven in straight scarlet lettering on blue ribbon \( \frac{1}{2} \)-in, wide and 4-in, long. It will be worn at the top of each sleeve of the service dress jacket or battle dress blouse above all other badges or signs.
  - 4. The arm badge will not be worn by Colonels, R.M., and above (acting, temporary or permanent).
