I ADMINISTRATIVE AND GENERAL**157/86 Introduction of new format DCIs (U)****[D/CS(PS)/3/1]**

1. This is the first of a new look DCI. Design changes have been made with two objectives. Firstly, to try to make DCIs more readable by using a different typeface and layout. Secondly, by altering the front cover, to give greater emphasis to the limited life of DCIs.
2. Since DCIs have a life of only one year, authors of DCIs should not refer to time-expired DCIs. CS(PS)E will, therefore, routinely remove all such references from draft DCIs.
3. MOD Manual 2 will be amended accordingly.
4. DCIs RN have the title page and contents list repeated as the last leaf, for removal and filing for one year as part of an accumulative index of extant DCIs.
