244/89 Uniform – introduction of a badge for Port Divers RNR (U)
[D/ST83/300/5/28: 82925A]

1. Approval has been given for the introduction of a new badge for Ships Divers RNR who have successfully completed Port Diving training.

Design

- The badge will be in the form of the letters 'PD' and will be worn below the existing RN Diving Branch badge.

Introductory arrangements

- The new badge will be issued gratuitously to all serving Port Divers RNR and to those qualifying in future to the scale laid down in BR 81, Annex 4D. It will be replaced free of charge on a fair wear and tear basis. Demands should be placed upon PSTO(N) Devonport and should be limited to initial requirements plus three months maintenance needs.

- A copy of this instruction is to be retained within the covers of BR 81 until its contents are incorporated in the text by routine amendment.
