**25/77. UNIFORMS—RN AND RNR RATINGS—BADGES—WEAR OF CPOs
BRANCH BADGES ON OVERALLS (U)**

[N/STE 1543/73 (ST 83A)]

1. In future, CPOs are to wear branch badges above the left breast pocket of overall suits, instead of on the right cuff. The change is to be effected *by 1 March 77*.
2. Badges will thus be less vulnerable to grease and dirt and more easily seen; uniformity with wear on No 8 shirts will also result.
3. Article 0438a of BR 81 (*The Uniform Regulations*) will be amended.
