82/87 Stores-Clothing-Issuing Prices of RN, RM, QARNNS and WRNS Officers' Clothing (U)

1. Issuing prices of items in the officers' clothing range have been reviewed in the light of current costs. Revised prices to be brought into force from 1 Apr 87 are shown in the ANNEXES to this DCI:

Notes:

1. The letter O after description indicates that the item is obsolescent and available from Service sources only while stocks remain.
 2. The symbol < indicates an increase in price
 3. The symbol > indicates a decrease in price
 4. VAT is to be charged on the sale of all cash clothing except:
 - a. In Fleet establishments abroad
 - b. In HM Ships outside territorial waters for more than 15 days or where a voyage of less than 15 days includes a call at a foreign port.
 - c. Where items are being purchased under the Personal Export Scheme (see BR 96 Part III Art 0482).
 5. Sales at FIPs are to be restricted to purchases by naval personnel for their own use.
2. To assist supply officers in highlighting the more substantial price increases/decreases those items showing price variations greater than £1.00 up or down at VAT exclusive rates have been underlined in ANNEXES A to D. It will be noted that there have been substantial price increases on RSNs V026-99-1325101/5126 Blouse working dress, V026-99-1388386/8417 Bush jackets and V035-99-132642/6373 WRNS Officers' Mess dress blouse (Mandarin and Peter Pan Collar). These are due to increased cost of materials combined with the effect of obtaining only the small quantities required.
3. Revised prices for made-to-measure items are not yet available pending receipt of new contracts commencing 1 Apr 87. These prices will be promulgated separately.
4. Revised rates of officers' Uniform Upkeep Allowances effective from 1 Apr 87 will be promulgated separately.
