1. Issuing prices of items in the officers' clothing range have been reviewed in the light of current costs. Revised prices to be brought into force from 1 Apr 92 are shown in the ANNEXES to this DCI:

- ANNEX A: Issuing prices of naval officers' clothing
- ANNEX B: Issuing prices of RM officers' clothing
- ANNEX C: Issuing prices of QARNNS officers' clothing
- ANNEX D Issuing prices of WRNS officers' clothing

Notes:

- (1) The letter O after the description indicates that the item is obsolescent and available from Service sources only while stocks remain.
 - (2) The symbol < indicates an increase in price.
 - (3) The symbol > indicates a decrease in price.
 - (4) VAT is to be charged on the sale of all items except:
 - a. In Fleet establishments abroad.
 - b. In HM ships outside territorial waters for more than 15 days or where a voyage of less than 15 days includes a call at a foreign port.
 - c. Where items are being purchased under the Personal Export Scheme (see BR 96, Part III, Article 0482).
 - (5) Sales at FIPs are to be restricted to purchases by naval personnel for their own use.
2. To assist supply officers in highlighting the more substantial price increases/decreases those items showing price variations greater than £2.00 up or down at VAT exclusive rates have been italicized in ANNEXES A to D.
3. Revised rates of Officers Uniform Relief (OUR) and midshipmans Uniform Upkeep Allowance (UUA) effective from 1 Apr 92 will be separately promulgated.
4. *Special note.* With the advent of the one for one exchange system for ratings' and RM warrant officers, NCOs and mens' clothing from April 1992 it is not intended to promulgate revised FIPs for these items by DCI in future. Instead they will be issued by letter through Commands early in March each year. For completeness sake the list of Officers' FIPs will henceforth include the prices of those garments such as Trousers, working, worsted/polyester, blue worn in common with ratings and RM warrant officers, NCOs and men.
