T61/76. UNIFORM—BADGES—RN RATINGS—TACTICAL COMMUNICATIONS SUB-BRANCH OF THE OPERATIONS BRANCH (U)

[N/STE 753/73 (DGST(N)83A)]

1. In future Junior ratings in the Tactical Communications sub-branch of the Operations Branch are to wear branch badges incorporating the crossed-flags device already authorized for men qualified professionally for Chief Communications and Communications Yeomen.
2. Badges are available as detailed in the Annex to this DCI and demands, limited to three months' requirements, may be lodged with PSTO(N) Devonport.
3. Serving ratings who are currently wearing badges bearing the wings and lightning flash device are to be given a free issue of the new badges to the scale in Item 261 of Appendix 16 to BR 96 (*Stores Accounting and Storekeeping Manual*).
4. Ratings joining the sub-branch in future are to be given the new badges on completion of Part II Training.
5. The arrangements for Tactical Communications ratings in ANNEX A to DCI (RN) S200/74 are superseded accordingly. BR 81 (*The Uniform Regulations*) will be amended.
