236/77. STORES—CLOTHING—ISSUING PRICES, KIT UPKEEP ALLOWANCES, ETC. (U)

[N/STE63/77(DGSTONR)]

1. The issuing prices of clothing have been reviewed in the light of current costs. revised prices are set out in ANNEXES B to I of this DCI.
2. The rates of Kit Upkeep Allowance, Clothing Gratuities etc have been calculated from the revised issuing prices and the new rates and amounts are set out in ANNEX A.
3. The revised rates of KUA will apply from 1 April 1977 and the new issuing prices are to be brought into force at the earliest possible date thereafter but not later than 1 May 1977.
4. The various price lists, rates of allowances etc are shown in the ANNEXES.
