II. SERVICE PERSONNEL

290/85. UNIFORM—BADGES—IMPROVED SUBMARINE BADGE (U)

[DGST(N)83A-D/ST83/300/5/22]

1. An improved submarine badge is being introduced to replace the current pattern.

2. **Design.** The appearance of the badge is unchanged but the fastening has been improved, with longer pins to the badge and new clutch fasteners.
3. **Storekeeping instructions.** Accounting details for the new badge and spare clutches are shown in the ANNEX.
4. Stocks of the old badge are now exhausted and demands should in future be lodged for the new badge. Spare clutches are also being obtained and demands placed now will be satisfied as stocks are received.
5. Spare clutches for the old badge, (RNSTS stock number V095-99-138 8429), will continue to be stocked by PSTO(N) Devonport.
