UNIFORM—BADGES—IMPROVED SUBMARINE BADGE (U) 290/85.

An improved submarine badge is being introduced to replace the current pattern.

2. Design. The appearance of the badge is unchanged but the fastening has been improved, with longer pins to the badge and new clutch fasteners.

3. Storekeeping instructions. Accounting details for the new badge and spare clutches are shown in the ANNEX.


