(U)†428.—Uniform—Royal Marines—Anodised Badges and Buttons (V.3A/191/4/61.—12 Mar. 1965.)

- 1. With effect from the 1st April, 1965 the issue of gilt and gilding metal badges and buttons for wear on Royal Marines other ranks uniforms will be discontinued.
- 2. New Entries.—Men entered on or after 1st April, 1965 are to be issued with anodised badges and buttons instead of the gilt and gilding metal items.
- 3. Serving Ranks.—Serving ranks are to provide themselves with the anodised items in the normal course of kit maintenance before the 1st April, 1966.
- 4. Promotions to Sergeant.—The gratuitous issue of anodised badges and buttons authorised by B.R. 93 (Manual of Victualling), Article 1121, is to be discontinued from 1st April, 1965.
- 5. The Uniform Regulations for N.C.Os. and men, Royal Marines, and B.R. 93 will be amended.
