## (U)459.—Uniform—Badges—RN Fleet Chief Petty Officers, Fleet Chief Wrens and RM Regimental Sergeants Major

(N/STE 4/70—23 Apr 71)

1. DCI (RN) 923/70 announced the introduction of Fleet Chief Petty Officers into the rating structure of the Royal Navy. Paragraph 39 of that Instruction indicated that Fleet Chief Petty Officers would wear the same uniform as Chief Petty Officers with new badges. It also gave a brief description of these badges of which further details are contained in Annex A to this Instruction.

- 2. The new hat and cap badges, beret and collar/tie badges and badges for foul-2. The new hat and cap bauges, but the same manner and with the same dresses as weather garments are to be worn in the same manner and with the same dresses as those worn by Chief Petty Officers at present.
- 3. The new Royal Arms rating badges (Vocab 31022 in gold wire for RN personnel) 3. The new Royal Allis lating of WRNS personnel) are to be worn on the left cuff and Vocab 50022 blue on blue for WRNS personnel above the three Children and Vocab 50022 blue on blue for WRNS personnel are to be worn on the left cuff and vocab 50022 blue on blue uniform jackets and mess jackets centrally 1-in above the three Chief Petty of blue uniform jackets and mess jackets centrally 1-in above the three Chief Petty of blue uniform jackets and are to be retained on both sleeves). An anodised metal Officers' cuff buttons (which are to be retained on both sleeves). Unicers cuit buttons (which all a constant and mess jackets badge also depicting the Royal Arms is to be worn on white tunics and mess jackets badge also depicting the left cuff. Red badges are not being provided and no other similarly positioned on the left cuff. Red badges are not being provided and no other Branch, Specialist Qualification or skill badges are to be worn, except:
  - a. Flying and Parachutist badges; centrally 1-in above the rating badge on blue uniform jackets and in the same manner as for Chief Petty Officers on other garments;
  - b. the existing Master-at-Arms Branch badge (Vocab 31172); on the right cuff or wrist with white uniform as by Chief Petty Officers at present and in addition to be similarly worn on blue uniform jackets and mess jackets.
- 4. Beret Badges.—WRNS personnel are to wear hat badge (Vocab No 50011) on berets. A special metal badge (Vocab No 35023) is being provided for RN Fleet Chief Petty Officers but supplies will not be available from production for immediate use and the existing Chief Petty Officers' badge (Vocab No 35006) should continue to be worn as an interim measure.
- 5. Collar Badges for WRNS.—In addition to wear in accordance with paragraph 2 above, collar badges (Vocab 35017) are to be worn by Fleet Chief Wrens on white tropical dresses. These badges are to be placed in the middle of each lapel with the centre of the badge level with the lapel point.
- 6. Royal Marines Regimental Sergeants Major.—The Royal Arms badge (Vocab 31022) is larger than the badges of similar design (Vocab 31920 and Vocab 39920) worn at present by Regimental Sergeants Major in the Royal Marines. In future the latter will be required to wear badges of the same size as those provided for Fleet Chief Petty Officers. A gratuitous issue of one badge (Vocab 31022) is therefore to be made to each serving Regimental Sergeant Major, for wear on his blue tunic. No further issues of the present gold badge (Vocab 31920) are to be made and any remaining stocks are to be returned to Principal Supply and Transport Officer (Naval), Royal William Yard, Plymouth. The gold on green badge (Vocab 39920) worn on lovat uniforms is also to be replaced by a larger badge but stocks are not yet available and a further announcement will be made when these are received and issues can be made.
- 7. Demands for badges may be lodged with the Principal Supply and Transport Officer (Naval), Royal William Yard, Plymouth and should be limited to quantities actually required for first issue to newly advanced ratings. Gratuitous issues may be made as indicated in Annex B to this Instruction in accordance with the general regulations in Chapter 11 (for RN) and Chapter 13 (for WRNS) of BR 93 (The Victualling Manual).
- 8. BR 81 (The Uniform Regulations) and BR 93 (The Victualling Manual) will be amended amended.
