(U)586.—Uniform—Officers—Shoulder Straps for Admirals of the Fleet and other Officers of Flag Rank Holding Royal Appointments—Position of Royal Cypher

(N/V6A/108/2/65-22 Apr 1966)

- 1. The devices on the shoulder straps for Admirals of the Fleet and other officers of Flag Rank entitled to wear the Royal Cypher have been re-positioned. In future, the Royal Cypher will be placed at the base of the strap below all the other devices, instead of immediately below the Crown as hitherto. In its new position the Cypher will be evenly and centrally disposed on the bottom edge of the gold lace of the shoulder strap.
- 2. Officers concerned should make arrangements to have their shoulder straps altered as necessary. Enquiries indicate that this can be done at a nominal charge.
- 3. The Uniform Regulations will be amended.
