- 1. Members of the Q.A.R.N.N.S. Auxiliary Section are in future to wear the gold on blue Red Cross badge, Vocab. No. 31354, on their blue uniform suit on being rated up to Naval Nursing Auxiliary. The badge is to be worn on the right arm of the jacket, mid-way between the point of the shoulder and the point of the elbow, or immediately below Queen Alexandra's monogram if this is worn.
- 2. Members already rated as Naval Nursing Auxiliaries and those rated in future are to be given a gratuitous issue of the badge.
- 3. The Uniform Regulations and B.R. 93 (Victualling Manual) will be amended.
