S32. UNIFORM—RN, RM, WRNS, QARNNS AND RESERVE OFFICERS—
PROVISION OF “STAFF” TYPE AIGUILLETES AND SHOULDER
STRAPS (U)

[N/STE 2624/70 (DG(GV))]

1. The arrangements for supply of “Staff” type Aiguillettes have been reviewed. Cash grants will no longer be paid and in future qualified officers who are not already in possession of a serviceable aiguillette and shoulder strap may obtain these items on loan from Service sources when appointed to one of the posts listed in ANNEX A to this DCI. Officers who have been paid a cash grant for an aiguillette and shoulder strap required in their present appointment will not be eligible to draw further items on loan.
