

(U)1031.—Uniform—W.R.N.S.—Ratings and Naval Nursing Auxiliaries—Issue of Gilt Buttons on Advancement

(V.6A/223/8/64.—16 Oct. 1964.)

1. The gratuitous issues of gilt buttons to W.R.N.S. ratings and Naval Nursing Auxiliaries for change of uniform on advancement are in future to be as follows:—

Asst. Head N.N.A.	10 (3 for jacket, 7 for overcoat)	—

Additional issues when serving on stations where tropical clothing is worn:—

P.O. Wren	12 (2 sets for white dresses)	—
Chief Wren	—	8 (2 sets for tropical shirts)
Asst. Head N.N.A.	12 (2 sets for white dresses)	—

2. The issues to P.O. Wren apply equally to Local Acting P.O. Wrens, who are required to change their buttons but not their headgear.
