

101.—Dress of Officers—R.M. Band Service.

(B. 2062/32.)

Their Lordships have approved of Officers and Warrant Officers, R.M. Band, wearing the same pattern cap (badge excepted) as other Officers of the Corps, as described in para. 9 on page 121 of the current Appendix to the Navy List.

2. Officers concerned are to be in possession of the new pattern cap by 1st April, 1933.

3. No charge against the public will be admitted in consequence of this change.

4. Consequent upon the foregoing, the following amendment will be made to the Dress Regulations for Officers, R.M., on the occasion of the next reprint of the Appendix to the Navy List:—

Page 121, para. 9A.—*Cancel and substitute:—*

“9A. *Cap, R.M. Band.*—As described in para. 9, but badge to consist of a gilt metal laurel wreath surrounding a silver globe surmounted by a gilt metal lyre.”
