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Instructions for making up Chevrons and
Good Conduct Badges.

In future the following instructions are to be observed in making up chevrons and badges for all garments.

Chevrons.—To be made so as to allow a distance of one inch between the outer edges of the cloth, or of the lace in the case of chevrons which are not mounted upon cloth, and the seams of the sleeve.

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Badges, as above, the distance to be half an inch.

In the case of men requiring very broad, or very narrow, sleeves these distances may be varied to suit the circumstances; but the above instructions should be adhered to as nearly as possible.
