4. *Attestations and Records.*

They will be borne on the shore strength of the corps. Each man will be allotted a Chatham (S.) number.

Attestations will be kept at Chatham, and a record of service will be kept on form R. 102, which will be attached to Attestation Paper.

5. *Pay.*

The Company and attached R.M.L.I. will be borne on Monthly Company Pay List at Chatham, the necessary cash being forwarded weekly by cheque by the Divisional Paymaster to the O.C. Company, who will pay the men advances on Acquittance Rolls in the usual manner.

Demands for all additional stores and for stores in replacement of others which are worn out or deficient are to be forwarded to the Adjutant-General, Royal Marines, for approval. No stores of any description are to be obtained as a charge to Marine Votes without the express authority of the Adjutant-General, R.M.

The following waterproof clothing will be issued on loan:—

All clothing and necessaries will be replaced, free of cost to the men, when worn out by fair wear and tear, under the provisions of M.O. 191/1914.
