Dress of Officers.

With reference to G.O. /49, May 1911, in future Whistle Cords, when worn, are to be looped over the left shoulder, the whistle being carried in the left breast pocket, the Army pattern cord being used, the colour to be blue for R.M.A., and Green for R.M.L.I.

With reference to Admiralty Weekly Order No. 499, dated 4th April, 1912, the White Linen Collar authorised to be worn by Officers with the Blue Serge Frock is to be attached to the garment so as to ensure a neat and uniform appearance. This order is to take effect as from the 1st May, 1912.
