H.M. Order in Council of the 14th July 1899 having authorised the title of Quartermaster-Sergeant Instructor for First Sergeant Instructors of Gunnery, Musketry, Infantry, Gymnastics, and Swimming, and that they be raised from Class III. to Class II. for purposes of pension,
