G.O. 53. With reference to G.O./38, February, 1917, the Royal  
Mar. Marine Labour Companies will in future be known as the  
1917. "Royal Marine Labour Corps," the Companies being designated by the name of the port at which they are stationed.

Officers and Men who, when on leave in England, require an extension of leave under special circumstances, will forward their applications to the Adjutant General, Royal Marines, Admiralty, 35, Spring Gardens, S. W. (1) in the case of Officers, and to the Commandant, Dépôt Royal Marines, Deal, in the case of all other ranks.
