The distinguishing badges to be worn by the respective ranks of N.C. Officers employed as Instructors, R.M.A., and R.M.L.I.—are as shewn in appendix C.

In the event of a N.C. Officer being discharged from the Service whilst holding an appointment, the badges are to be returned into Casualty Store with the clothing, unless the latter has been the prescribed period in wear, and if the appointment is vacated for any other reason, the badges are always to be returned, unless they have been the full time in wear (Tunic 2 years, Frock 1 year).
