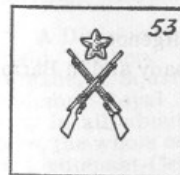

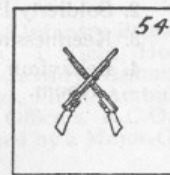

NOTE 1.—Sergeants permanently employed on shore receive 1½d. per diem, in addition to above rates.

NOTE 2.—Gunnery, 2nd Class, R.M.A., Privates, R.M.A. (previous to transfer to rank of Gunner, 2nd class), and Privates, R.M.L.I., receive 2d. per diem after six months' training, and having completed their recruit Infantry training, or attained the age of 19, whichever occurs first.

NOTE 3.—Gunnery, 2nd class, on completion of sea service course, and having obtained not less than 80 per cent. of marks, are to be advanced to Gunner, 1st Class, with full pay of Gunner (1s. 9d. per diem).

NOTE 4.—Afloat allowance is paid to N.C.O.'s and men embarked on completing three years man's service at the following rates:—

Corporal and above	4d. per diem.
Private	3d. per diem.

NOTE 5.—War bonus from 1-2-18:—Private 1/6; Paid Lce.-Corpl. and Corpl. 1/9; Paid Lce.-Sergt. and Sergt. 2/-; W.O. (Class II.) 2/6; W.O. (Class I.) 3/-

OTHER ALLOWANCES.

Good Conduct Pay:—1d. per diem for each Good Conduct Badge.

Gunnery Allowances:—
