Blue Battle Dress - Arm Badge "Royal Marines".

The woven arm badge "Royal Marines" scarlet on blue is in future to be worn on the blue battle dress blouse instead of shoulder titles "R.M." The badge will normally be issued already sewn on the garment. The position of the badge on the blue blouse will correspond with that on the khaki blouse.

2. R.M. Band ranks will continue to wear shoulder titles "R.M.B".

3. Additional requirements of Arm badges "Royal Marines" should be demanded through normal channels.

4. G.O. 30/43 has been amended this day. Previous decisions on the wearing of shoulder titles "R.M." with blue battle dress are hereby cancelled.
