Service Dress Clothing for issue to Naval Personnel.

Commanders-in-Chief of the three Home Ports have been informed by Admiralty Letter M.02022/40 of 30.1.40 that certain Naval ratings (44 in all) can be equipped with 2 suits of service dress clothing (without shoulder titles), 2 caps service dress and 1 pair of puttees at the R.M. Division adjacent to their Depot. Although it is the intention that Naval buttons shall be substituted for R.M. buttons in due course, R.M. buttons need not be removed before issue.
