CIRCULAR

Embroidered Badge "Royal Marines" for wear
on Battle Dress and Service Dress - Introduction.

An A.P.O. will shortly be issued notifying the introduction of an arm badge showing the designation "Royal Marines" woven in straight scarlet lettering on blue ribbon $\frac{1}{2}$ inch wide and 4 inches long, for wear with service dress and battle dress.

2. The scale of issue will be 2 for each suit of battle dress or service dress in the authorised kit and the badge will be worn at the top of each sleeve above all other badges and signs. Metal shoulder titles will not be worn with these arm badges.

3. The arm badge will not be worn by Colonels, R.M. and above. (Acting, Temporary or Permanent)

4. Supplies will shortly be made to R.M. Establishments from the Contractors (Messrs. J. & J. Cash, Ltd, Coventry) as follows :-

Chatham Division, R.M.....	40,000
Portsmouth Division, R.M....	40,000
Plymouth Division, R.M.....	40,000
R.M.R.D., Exton.....	30,000

5. Cost will be 38s/2d. per 1,000 and is to be shown under D.of C. as an excess for the current year.

6. Arm Badges are to be issued and sewn on at the earliest possible date.
