CIRCULAR.

Dress - Officers.


In future, Armlets will only be worn by Staff Officers on duty with troops or when visiting the Headquarters of Formations in the United Kingdom. The necessary amendment to paragraph 154, Dress Regulations for the Army, 1934, will be made in due course.

2. Para. 3 of R.M.O. Circular No.5079/39.Q. of 25.9.39, is to be amended to read as follows :-

"All Officers and Warrant Officers will wear the cross-belt or brass whenever the Sam Browne belt is worn".

The necessary amendment to A.C.I. 466 of 1940, as amended by A.C.I. 722 of 1940, will be published in due course.

3. R.M.O. Circular No. 5079/39.Q. of 24.9.40 is hereby cancelled.
