Combined Operations Personnel - Special Badge.


With reference to A.F.O.4366/42, so far as Royal Marines are concerned only personnel of the following Units are entitled to wear the Combined Operations Badge:-

40 R.M. Commando.
41 R.M. Commando.
Guns Crews of L.C.F. (L).
Guns Crews of L.C.S. (L) and L.C.S. (M).
R.M. Boom Patrol Detachment.
Special Engineering Unit.

2. The badge will be worn on battle dress only, immediately below the woven arm badge "Royal Marines", or, in the case of R.M. Commandos, immediately below the "Commando" arm badge. A battle dress blouse showing the position of the badge (specimen marked "3") has been circulated to R.M. Units concerned.

3. In cases where the badge cannot be worn on both arms (e.g. King's badgers, and instructors), it will be worn only on the one arm.
