Combined Operations Personnel - Special Badge.

With reference to A.F.O.4366/42, so far as Royal Marines are concerned only personnel of the following Units are entitled to wear the Combined Operations Badge:-


40 R.M.Commando.
41 R.M.Commando.
Guns Crews of L.C.F. (L).
Guns Crews of L.C.S. (L) and L.C.S. (M).
R.M.Boom Patrol Detachment.
Special Engineering Unit.

2. The badge will be worn on both arms of the khaki battle-dress blouse and blue serge tunic, immediately below the woven arm badge "Royal Marines" in the case of battle-dress blouse and 1-inch below the point of the shoulder in the case of the blue serge tunic. R.M.Commandos will wear the badge immediately below the woven arm badge "Commando".

3. In cases where the badge cannot be worn on both arms (e.g.King's badgemen, and Instructors), it will be worn on the one arm.

4. R.M.Circular of this number dated 2.12.42 is cancelled.
