CIRCULAR.

ROYAL MARINE LABOUR COMPANY.

With reference to Circular R.N. No. 2700/40.A., dated 4th January, 1940, the Labour Company will be utilised for working parties at Fleet bases, etc., as required.

2. The Company is to be organised in Platoons of 50, each under a N.C.O.
3. The men are to receive sufficient elementary disciplinary training to enable them to be moved about in organised formations and to salute.
4. Should the first 100 men be drafted before the second 100 are required, two of the four N.C.Os. are to remain to organise and train the third and fourth platoons.
