CAP & HELMET ORNAMENTS, R.M.DIVISIONAL BANDS.
THE KING'S BADGE.

His Majesty The King has signified his approval, as stated below, of the R.M.Divisional Bands' Cap and Helmet Ornaments, and the King's Badge:-

Chatham - No change; the White Rose of York to be retained.

Portsmouth - No change; the Royal Cypher "G.R.V" to be retained.

Plymouth - No change; the Prince of Wales's Plume to be retained.

H.M.Yacht - The special badge to be discontinued, viz., a R.M. Band embarked in H.M.Yacht will wear its own distinctive badge.

The King's Badge - No change; the Royal Cypher "G.R.V" to be retained.

2. Necessary amendments to G.S.O., S.I. and Establishment of Stores, Part I, have been issued this day.

3. The Commandant, Portsmouth Division, will please report whether any reduction in the establishment of Cap Badges, pattern 272, can be effected in consequence of the decision to discontinue the special badge for H.M.Yacht and, if so, forward proposed amendments to Establishment of Stores, Part I.
