Company Sergeants Major - Badge of Rank.

It has been decided that Company Sergeants Major shall in future wear the same badge of rank as Quartermaster Sergeants, i.e., Crown and Wreath.


2. Establishment of Stores, Part I, is to be amended as follows :-

Page 6, Line 8 - delete all detail.

Line 16 - Amend cols. 5, 6, 7 and 8 to read "60", "110", "60" and "65" respectively; insert in col. 9 "and Company Sergeants Major".

3. Requisitions for Army pattern badges required in consequence of this change may be rendered to O.S. (P.5), Branston, direct. Gold embroidered badges may be ordered under Standing Contracts as necessary, the cost being shown as an excess expenditure under D. of C. in liability statement due in office on 1st July, 1940.
