Introduction. In future, black-on-green rank badges are to be worn by all officers, WOs and NCOs on temperate combat jackets and the use of khaki serge badges is to be discontinued. At the same time, new black-on-green rank badges for WOs are being introduced for wear on both temperate combat jackets and jerseys wool heavy (JWH) in place of the anodised badges in current use.
