191. FORMATION OF THE MOUNTAIN AND ARCTIC WARFARE CADRE

- The M and AW Cadre will form as a sub unit of Commando Forces RM at Stonehouse Barracks on 2nd November 1970 and will move to Arbroath on 1st April 1971.
- The Cadre will be under the administrative command of the Commanding Officer 45 Commando RM, who will provide medical, technical and administrative backing.
- The Officer Commanding M and AW Cadre will be responsible to the Major General Royal Marines Commando Forces for the following functions: -
 - To assist in training 45 Commando Group in M and AW for operations on the northern flank of NATO.
 - To train special parties and detachments including RMR destined for operations in sub zero temperatures.
 - To advise on M and AW techniques, clothing and equipment.
 - To provide material for M and AW instructional handbooks. d.
 - To foster the techniques of climbing, mountaineering and skiing. e.
