030* 3 COMMANDO BRIGADE HEADQUARTERS & SIGNAL SQUADRON ROYAL MARINES - CHANGE OF TITLE

- CINCFLEET has directed that 3 Commando Brigade Headquarters & Signal Squadron Royal Marines is to change its name to more accurately reflect its size and functions as part of an expeditionary Formation. With effect from 26 Jun 01, it will be known as the United Kingdom Landing Force Command Support Group (UKLF CSG).
- The UKLF CSG, in addition to communications and brigade staff support, will continue to provide key enabling capabilities to the Commando Brigade, hosting some assets that would normally be found at Divisional level and in other signals units. The UKLF CSG is classified as a major unit within the Royal Marines Command (RMC) and is commanded by a Lieutenant Colonel Royal Marines, selected by the Military Command Board.
- The wire diagram at Annex A depicts the new structure. The UKLF CSG consists of:
 - a. A CSG Headquarters Troop.
 - b. A Support Squadron, including the Air Defence Troop, the Electronic Warfare Troop (Y Troop), the Royal Marines Police Troop, the Brigade Patrol Troop and the Brigade Tactical Air Control Parties.
 - c. A Communications Squadron, including two deployable Headquarters Troops each with a VSC 501 Detachment.
 - d. A Logistic Squadron, including the QM's Department, the Equipment Support Troop and Motor Transport Troop.
 - e. A Brigade Staff Squadron.
- 4. The new SMA is UKLF CSG. Further information regarding e-mail addresses and telephone numbers will be issued separately.
